Canutillo ISD Department of Finance Accolades

- CISD is the first district in the region to produce a comprehensive annual financial report (CAFR). The CAFR is a set of U.S. government financial statements comprising the financial report of a state, municipal or other governmental entity that complies with the accounting requirements promulgated by the GASB.
 - In 2020, for the fourth consecutive year, Canutillo ISD was awarded the Certificate of Achievement (COA) for Excellence in Financial Reporting by the Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA) for its fiscal year 2019 comprehensive annual financial report (CAFR). The Certificate of Achievement is the highest form of recognition in the area of governmental accounting and financial reporting and its attainment represents a significant accomplishment by a government and its management. The 2020 CAFR is still under review.
- For the fifth consecutive year, Canutillo ISD was awarded the Certificate of Excellence in Financial Reporting (COE) by the Association of School Business Officials International (ASBO). ASBO International's COE recognizes districts that have met the program's high standards for financial reporting and accountability. CISD earned the Certificate of Excellence for its Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR) for the 2020 fiscal year.

Canutillo ISD improved its credit rating and is now among the best-rated school systems in the region. Moody's Investors Service upgraded Canutillo Independent School District's credit rating to Aa3, from A1.

- The Texas Association of School Business Officials (TASBO) announced that Canutillo ISD is one of 53 educational organizations in the state to be recognized for following best practices in the area of purchasing operations. TASBO's Purchasing Award of Merit was created to recognize Texas school districts, open-enrollment charter schools, and education services centers that are committed to following professional standards in the acquisition of goods and services.
- Canutillo ISD Chief Business Officer Martha E. Piekarski was selected by the Texas Society of Certified Public Accountants (TxCPA) to serve on the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants (AICPA) Council at the national level. TxCPA is the largest, most influential association of accounting and finance professionals in Texas The Texas CPA Nominations Committee recommended that Ms. Piekarski, be forwarded to the AICPA to serve as a representative from Texas for a three-year term from May 2022 through May 2025. She has been accepted by the AICPA and appointed to the Professional Ethics Committee. The AICPA is the world's largest member association representing the accounting profession.
